Requesting a Preferred Roommate

- If you have requested a preferred roommate, make certain you have indicated their accurate Internet ID on your application-contract and they have indicated your correct Internet ID on their application-contract.
- If you do not yet know their Internet ID, skip this section, submit your application and update the information online when known at: www.housing.umn.edu by logging into your Online Housing Account.

Roommate Matching Questions

- Will be considered if no preferred roommate request is received prior to assignments being made.

(Preferred method)

- Know your Internet ID and Password.
- Have a printer to print out your Application Summary.
- Include your parental/legal guardian signature if you are under 18 years of age.
- Have a valid credit card to charge the \$25 non-refundable Housing Application Fee. Payment is necessary to complete your application. You can also pay by check or money order. Please include your student ID number on your check.

- **When you submit your building, room types, and meal plan preferences online @ www.housing.umn.edu/housing_preferences, make sure your top room type preferences are in your top building preference.**

Paper Application

- Know your Student ID number and Internet ID.
- Complete and sign the application-contract.
- Include your parental/legal guardian signature if you are under 18 years of age.
Include a check or money order for the \$25 (non-refundable Housing Application Fee).
- Please include your student ID number on your check.



May 1 Guarantee

All Incoming Freshman who submit a complete housing application, are admitted to the University and confirm their enrollment all by May 1, are guaranteed a space in housing. Typically incoming first-year freshman applying before but closer to the May 1 Housing Guarantee deadline are assigned to an expanded housing space.
